



## Educational Field Trip Report

### SEC—Historical Tourism in Assam and North-East India: Sri Surya Pahar, Goalpara

On 24-12-2021 the Department of History, P.B. College, Gauripur organized an educational field trip to Sri Surya Pahar located in Goalpara, Assam. The trip was aimed at providing students with an enriching of historical and archaeological significance, as well as to explore the cultural heritage of Assam.

The trip commenced at 7.00 A.M. from the college campus with the students of 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester (Regular) and the faculty members of History Department along with other departments by 3 (three) buses.

The journey to Sri Surya Pahar took approximately 3 and half hour, passing through scenic landscapes of Assam.
