THE REPORT

On September 12, 2024, the Departments of Management, Finance, and Accountancy of P.B. College jointly organized an insightful Exposure Session on Entrepreneurship for B. Com 5th Semester students. The session, held at the Digital Classroom of P.B. College, aimed at broadening the entrepreneurial outlook of students and fostering a spirit of innovation. The guest speaker for the event was Mr. Biplob Debnath, a well-known local entrepreneur and owner of Debnath Stores, Gauripur. The session commenced at 1:00 P.M., witnessing enthusiastic participation from students and faculty members alike.

Opening Remarks and Introduction of the Guest Speaker

The session began with an inaugural address by Mr. Diganta Biswas, Assistant Professor and Head of the Department of Accountancy. 
