Pramathesh Barua College, Gauripur offers BA and B.Com regular and honours programmes under UG-CBCS semester system. The College offers Honours in 7 subjects in the BA Programme and 3 subjects in the B.Com Programme. The college offers Honours in English, Assamese, Bengali, Political Science, Economics, History, Philosophy and Education in BA; and Finance, accountancy and Management in B.Com courses. All the courses are aimed at increasing the knowledge and skill of the students in the respective subjects and enable them to engage in various fields. The focus is on enhancing subject related theoretical knowledge along with bringing in practical understanding to enhance employability of students. The program and course outcome of various disciplines have been stated below.

Programme Outcomes of BA

After completion of six semesters a student can achieve a Bachelor of Arts Degree. A student who finishes B.A in Arts acquire knowledge in the field of social science, literature and humanities.

- A student who graduates in Arts becomes sensitive towards his/her academic/social atmosphere.
- B.A graduates become acquainted with the society's social, economic, cultural, historical, philosophical, geographical tradition.
- The programme empowers students with such foundational knowledge that they can further pursue various competitive exams.
- Along with theoretical knowledge, the programme also imbibes ethical knowledge and values in students.
- The course lays foundation in a student's mind to tackle larger problems of life and society.
- Arts is not just imparting knowledge but also teaching students its practical implementation.
- The programme also inculcates civic values in students and nurtures them to be better citizens.

Programme Outcomes of B.Com

The college offers honours as well as regular course in B.Com. As P.B College is the only college in the District with a sanctioned faculty for teaching Commerce, the college fulfils the crucial role of meeting the needs of students aspiring to study Commerce.

- The B.Com graduates will be able to get a basic and fundamental idea about commercial activities.
- The programme empowers students to get a grip of basic knowledge to succeed in businesses.
- The programme enables students to appear for various competitive exams along with professional courses like CA, CS, MBA etc.

Course Outcomes

B.A English (Honours)

- A graduate in English honours can take up interesting jobs in the field of journalism and mass communication.

B.A History (Hons)

- A degree in History familiarises a student with the past events of importance. And every civilisation goes forward while learning from its past.
- It encourages the students to study our legacies and take proud in our past achievements.
- It also enables students to study the historical blunders, draw lessons from past so that such is not repeated further.
- Most of India's contemporary problems have a root in History. To solve these problems an understanding of its historical roots is inevitable.
- History is also a favourite with students opting for competitive exams.
- Students of History has an edge as many job related exams have a large section on History.
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B.A Political Science (Hons)

- An honours degree in Political Science will familiarise a student with the political ethos of the country.
- A student will learn about the Indian Constitution and understand the role of the Constitution.
- The course enables students to understand the political changes happening in the country.
- It will encourage students to know about governance and hold elected representatives accountable by questioning.
- It helps students appearing for various competitive exams.
- Students can also be inspired to participate in politics and be a part of the system.
- Students can take up careers as political analyst, political adviser to elected representatives etc.

B.A Economics (Hons)

- A degree in Economics familiarises a student with the different financial institutions of the country and the role they play.
- Students will learn about various economic concepts which are crucial to a country's growth and development.
- Students will have an edge while applying for various competitive exams in the finance and banking sector.
- Students can also work as field researchers for different projects.

B.A Maths (Hons)

- Students become well versed in various fundamental mathematical theories.
- Maths inculcates logical reasoning in students and helps them in various competitive exams.

B.A Philosophy (Hons)

- Students who study this course become familiar with the teachings of known philosophers of all times.
- Students learn both about Eastern and Western philosophers and can also undertake a comparative study of the same.
- The logic part of the course enables a student to nurture the habit of logical reasoning.
- Philosophy is also a very popular choice in competitive civil service examinations and a graduation in this subject is very helpful.

- Philosophy also teaches students ethics and values inculcating in them the capability to evaluate good and bad.

B.A Education (Hons)

- A degree in education gives students the pedagogical knowledge of teaching.
- It gives an edge to students appearing for different exams for teaching jobs like TET, CTET.
- It helps students to understand the psychological aspect of teaching as well and inculcates a culture of professionalism in students who may become future teachers.

B.A Assamese (Hons)

- Assamese continues to be a popular choice for students as an honours subject and a degree in Assamese introduces the students with the canonical texts written in this language.
- It improves the efficiency of students in the state language of Assam.
- It inculcates a love for reading in students as literature's role is enhancing a student's horizon.
- It also teaches students the craft of writing which helps them choose professions like journalism.

B.A Bengali (Hons)

- A degree in Bengali introduces students to the rich literature present in the language.
- It also encourages students to inculcate a habit of writing.
- Students can further pursue Masters in the language.

Along with these, the college also offers regular courses in Hindi along with Classical languages like Arabic and Sanskrit. Students who study these subjects learn to read and write these languages with proficiency.

Programme Outcomes B.Com(Hons)

The curriculum planning of B.Com. (Hons.) course provides the students thorough and inclusive knowledge of the areas related to finance, human resource management, marketing, international business, corporate and business laws, accounting and taxation etc

- The graduates of this programme will be trained to develop skills and attitudes needed for critical thinking and adopting a comprehensive problem-solving approach. They shall be exposed to the pedagogy that helps them understand real life situations through case-studies.
- The teaching learning pedagogies used in the programme make the students capable enough to deliver and communicate information effectively with a mark.
- The courses aim at instituting entrepreneurial skills in the students by instilling in them competencies needed to become an entrepreneur. These would lead to
