

REGULATIONS OF THE UNDER GRADUATE CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (UGCBCS) GAUHATI UNIVERSITY, 2019

(AS AMENDED ON 8/11/2019)

1. THE CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

The Choice Based Credit System is the logical next step in a credit based semester system becoming more learner-centric. A CBCS offers the student a diversity of courses to choose from and the autonomy to decide on the place, pace and time of learning. The UGC has recommended that it is desirable for all institutions of Higher Education in the country to move to a CBCS and, together with it, implement a uniform grading system.

2. UNDER GRADUATE CBCS (UGCBCS) PROGRAMMES

The undergraduate degree programme in the CBCS will have courses spread across six- semesters. A typical semester will comprise a minimum of 15 to 18 weeks of academic work that will translate into 90 actual teaching days. Two consecutive (one odd and one even) semesters will make up an academic year. An UG course shall be of Six Semesters covering three Calendar Years (Academic Sessions – June to May). The duration of the Odd Semesters (First, Third and Fifth) shall be 'June to November', and that of Even Semesters (Second, Fourth and Sixth) shall be 'December to May'.

The dates and duration mentioned in the academic calendar concerned will be in consonance with the above schedule as far as practicable.

Each student must take admission in three consecutive Academic Sessions starting with the first semester. Students who do not enroll in the Second Academic Session will not be eligible to take admission in the Third Academic Session.

The minimum time requirement to acquire an undergraduate degree will be three years. The maximum time allowed to complete the programme will be six years.



so, she/he will have to take fresh admission in the first semester. Subject to the said condition, a student (with necessary credit/attendance) who could not appear or who failed in any semester examination will be allowed chance to clear the same as follows:

- i. First semester with regular third semester examination.
- ii. Second semester with regular fourth semester examination.
- iii. Third semester with regular fifth semester examination.
- iv. Fourth semester with regular sixth semester examination.

10.1.7 There shall be no scope for a student to appear as Private Candidate in any course.

10.1.8 Schedule: The schedule for examinations will be as per the concerned Academic Calendar. The exact dates of examinations and related information will be notified by the office of the Controller of Examinations, Gauhati University

10.2 Evaluation: A student's performance will be evaluated throughout the year based on continuous assessment. Evaluation of the student's performance in each semester for every course will be based on the following:

- ✓ Internal Assessment (IA)
- End Semester Examination (ESE)

For a student to pass in a course, she/he has to pass on the basis of the marks secured in TOTALITY in both Internal Assessment and End Semester Examination.

10.2.1 Internal Assessment (IA): IA will ideally account for 20% of the total marks allotted to a course/paper. For evaluating the performance of the students in a continuous way, the following measures will be adopted for distributing marks earmarked for IA.

10.2.1a Sessional or mid-term examination will be conducted for 50% of the total marks allotted for IA of a course/paper. (For example, if 20 marks is allotted for IA of a course/paper, then 10 marks will be kept aside for assessment in sessional or mid-term examination. The sessional examination will be held for 30 marks for the convenience of setting questions and covering the syllabus and the marks secured by the students will be proportionately converted to be out of 10 marks. Duration of the examination will be one hour. The question papers of the sessional or mid

term examinations will be set by the concerned teacher(s) and the evaluated answer scripts will be shown to the students and corrections will be made, if any.

10.2.1b 20% of the marks allotted for IA will be awarded to the students based on class attendance. If the total marks for IA is 20, then 4 marks will be awarded to the students based on class attendance. The following criteria will be adopted for awarding marks under this category

- a) Class attendance from 76% to 80% 1 mark;
- b) Class attendance from 81% to 85% 2 marks;
- c) Class attendance from 86% to 90% 3 marks;
- d) Class attendance from 91% and above 4 marks.

10.2.1c Rest 30% of the marks allotted (i.e. 6 marks) for IA will be distributed and awarded on the basis of performance of the students on the following criteria:

- i) for Practical Courses: Practical (internal practical including practical copy)
- ii) For non-practical courses :

Home assignments; Seminar/Group discussions; Field work; Performance in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

10.2.1d Internal marks will be scaled up/down to ensure a maximum permissible deviation of 20 percent from ESE marks. Thus, internal marks can deviate only within the mark band of % marks secured in ESE plus /minus 20 percent.

10.2.1e In case of ODI learners admitted under GUIDOL, IA will ideally account for 20 % of the total marks allotted to a course (in a manner similar to conventional mode students) and will be distributed as follows

- i) Sessional or Mid-term examinations will be conducted for 50% of the total marks allotted for IA of a course (in a manner similar to conventional mode students)
- ii) Rest 50% of the marks allotted for IA will be distributed and awarded on the basis of performance of students on the following criteria (in a manner similar to conventional mode students)



- Home assignments
- Seminars/Group discussions
- Field Work
- Performance in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

10.2.2 End Semester Examination (ESE):

The ESE will comprise of 80% of the total marks earmarked for a course. The ESE shall be of three hours duration for a course whose ESE component exceeds 50 marks. For a student to pass in a course/paper, her/his marks in both Internal Assessment and End Semester Examination will be accounted for in totality

For Courses with Practical, ESE will be conducted as per Theory (60 marks) plus Practical (20 marks)

For courses without practical the ESE will be conducted for 80 marks.

For odd semesters, ESE will be held in the month of November and for the even semesters, the examination will be held in the month of May.

10.2.3 Pass Marks

The conditions for successful completion (Pass) of a course is as per the Grading Template indicated in Section- 10.3.7

10.2.4 Number of Attempts

10.2.4a A student who has completed a semester may be allowed to proceed to the next semester, irrespective of the number of papers in which she/he failed.



Policy Document of Examination Cell Pramathesh Barua College, Gauripur

1. Title: Examination Management Guideline

1.1. Chief Components:

- To conduct the End Semester Examination fixed by the Affiliated University
- To conduct the Internal assessment (IA) in the college
- To create a Policy for Examination Grievances and Redressal
- To maintain a mechanism for record-keeping
- To set up the Responsible Authority and Appellate Authority
- Other Functional areas of the policy

2. Introduction

In consonance with the examination regulations of Affiliating University (GU) of the Three Years Degree Course (2017), Pramathesh Barua College reconstituted the 'Examination Cell' in concurrence with the approval of the Governing Body of the college. The college's principal heads a committee as the chairperson, a convenor from a seniormost faculty members, two-thirds of faculty members (preferably HODs) and one-third of non-teaching staff.

3. Objectives of the Examination Cell

The objectives of the Examination Cell are as follows:

- To conduct both internal/external examinations of UG courses as per regulations and programs of Gauhati University.
- To motivate the departments to maintain transparency and uniformity in the evaluation process of all the examinations conducted for the UG programme.
- To maintain a systematic record of student's attendance and marks obtained in internal examinations.
- To redress the examination-specific grievances of the students.
- To assist IQAC of the college to analyse the results data of the college.

4. Conduct of End Semester Examination:

As an affiliated institution of Gauhati University, Pramathesh Barua College follows the rules and regulations for conducting end-semester examinations following a centrally published programme by the Controller of Examinations of the University. For smooth conduct of examination, the Principal of the college acts as officer-in-charge and selects two or three (based



on the number of examinees) Assistant Officer-in-charge from the faculty members and other office assistants. With a proper and unbiased seating plan, engagement of invigilators keeping in mind that no subject-concerned teachers are engaged in the room and adequate bio break facilities, safe drinking water facilities are ensured. The supervising Officers appointed at the centre are facilitated with proper documents. The answer scripts of day-to-day examinations are safely packed and sent to the respective zones fixed by the university. After the end of the examinations, all required papers and documents are sent to the University and so concern.

5. Conduct of Internal Examination:

- The examination cell of the college initiates and ensures the procedure of internal assessment for the odd and even semesters during the full academic session.
- Students are kept updated with information, notifications, and instructions relating to internal/ external examinations from time to time through the central notice board, WhatsApp and departmental notice boards.
- Internal assessments ideally account for 20% of the total marks allotted to a course. To evaluate the performance of the students continuously, the following measures are to be taken for the distribution of marks earmarked for IA:

- 5.1. A sessional examination is to be conducted for 50% of the total marks allotted for IA of a course/paper. For example, if 20 marks are allotted to a paper, then 10 marks are to be kept for assessment in a sessional examination. For the examination for this 10 marks, departments are given autonomy to set question papers of 20 to 30 marks at their convenience. Finally, marks are converted to 50% (i.e. in 10). The duration of the examination is one hour. The concerned teacher/ concerned department is to be given autonomy to set departmental routines for conducting major/honours courses and where less number of students enrolled. Normal classes need not be hampered while taking the assessment procedure.
- 5.2. In regular courses/ subjects where a higher number of students are enrolled, the Examination Cell prepare a central sessional routine, engages faculties as invigilators and conducts the examination.
- 5.3. The answer scripts are evaluated by the concerned department and a record of marks is kept along with the answer scripts and sample question papers. Centrally conducted examination answer scripts are distributed to the faculty concerned and instructed to submit marks foil to the Examination Cell within the stipulated time.



5.4. 20% of marks allotted for IA is to be awarded to students based on class attendance. If the total marks for IA is 20, then a maximum of 4 marks can be awarded to the students for maximum attendance as categorised below:

- Class Attendance (76 to 80%) - 1 marks
- Class Attendance (81 to 85%) - 2 marks
- Class Attendance (86 to 90%) - 3 marks
- Class Attendance (91 to 100%) - 4 marks

Rest 30% (i.e. 6 marks) for IA be distributed and awarded based on the performance of the students on the following criterion:

- Home Assignments/ Quizzes / Debates/ Presentations
- Seminar/ Group Discussions
- Fieldwork/ Co-curricular & Extra-Curricular Activities

5.5. The Examination Cell ensures all activities of departmental CIE and suggests proper record keeping of the same.

5.6. After ensuring that the concern is to be discussed about the marks obtained by the slow learners and accordingly suggest measures for improvement.

5.7. After uploading marks in the GU portal, necessary documents are to be given back to the concerned department for record-keeping and to meet up queries, if any.

6. Policy for examination-related grievances and redressal:

6.1. The Examination Cell of the college is to look into the examination-related grievances of the students. The cell is to ensure that students get prompt solutions to their problems. Also, the cell is to provide a platform for the students to express their grievances freely and that would be handled without any biases. The cell entertains the grievances and takes necessary steps for timely resolution.

6.2. Nature of internal/ external assessment-related grievances

- Non-compliance of internal examinations schedule due to valid reason
- Incorrect uploading of internal marks in the Grade sheet.
- Absence in Grade Sheet even after filling up of examination form
- A mismatch between the form fill-up and attendance sheet in the end-semester examination
- Non-satisfaction for obtaining marks in IA
- Late presence of students in end-semester examinations other than the scheduled time.
- Sick application and arrangement appeal for the sick room
- Student of arrear batch with internal marks issues.



6.3. Redress mechanism

The Examination Cell is accountable for the timely redress of the grievances raised by the students. It adheres to the examination guidelines of GU in letter and spirit for the semester examinations. The Cell follows a convincing mechanism for both the external and internal examinations held by the university and College/Departments as follows.

6.3.1. End-Semester Examination related redress mechanism

- Receives applications from students concerned and forwards the same for necessary correction with a forwarding of the Principal of the college with proper documentation (Grade sheet issue, absence issue, mismatch issue etc.)
- After half an hour of examination start time, no candidate is allowed to sit for the same examination.
- Ensuring proper availability of medical certificates, a sick student may be allowed for separate arrangement of sitting in the examination hall.

6.3.2. Internal Assessment related redress mechanism

- If a student is unable to attend the scheduled IA examination then his/her application with supportive documents is examined and the Examination Cell instruct the department concerned to schedule the examination with a set of new questions.
- If any student is not satisfied with marks attained in IA, the Cell may re-examine the paper by another teacher of the department for the satisfaction of the students.
- Project-related grievances are handled by the department concerned. HODs are sensitive to be cooperative for the purpose.

7. Mechanism for record-keeping:

The Examination Cell of the college is a hub of records relating to the internal and external examination. The Cell ensures all records are kept systematically and yearwise for both internal and external examination.

The Cell is to put all internal marks to the GU Portal subject-wise, exam-wise, and semester-wise in the form of spiral binding. Also, the Cell instructs the departments to keep records of the sessional marks obtained by the students for further queries.

8. Responsible Authority and Appellate Authority:


The department concerned is the responsible authority for setting question papers and holding examinations of Major/Honours courses. Hence, if any grievances come to the department, the department concerned meets up the grievances at their discretion or sends it to the examination cell for necessary action. The Examination Cell redresses the external examination-related




the examination cell for necessary action. The Examination Cell redresses the external examination-related grievances or sends them to the University with a forwarding of the Principal. The supreme appellate authority in college is the principal and the office of the principal takes appropriate action or instructs the Cell/Departments against any grievance coming to his office.

9. Functional area of the policy:

The functional area of the policy is extremely appropriate for P.B. College only. End-semester related may be dealt with by the University and IA IA-related redress mechanism comes into force for Pramathesh Barua College only.

4. Although 75% of attendance is mandatory, a student of any Major course who remains absent for 10 (ten) consecutive teaching days, except on genuine medical ground, shall forfeit his/her seat. However, submission of appeals, if any, on medical ground shall have to be forwarded by the concerned Head of the Department.
5. A student may be allowed to "Repeat" any one one of the Major papers in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Semester.
6. No "Repeat" shall be allowed in 4th, 5th and 6th Semester.
7. Since the Semester system involves continuous assessment, there would be no scope for a student to appear as a private/non collegiate candidate in any subject.
8. No College transfer is allowed except in case of parents' transfer of service.
9. For any matter not covered under this Regulation for Semester System the existing University Rules and the Gauhati University Act 1949 (as amended till date) shall be applicable.

(B) Procedure for Internal Evaluation :

As per Regulation of Three years Degree Course (TDC) semester system with credit and Grade Continued in Academic Council meeting held on 27th October, 2017 the marks allotted for internal evaluation in each paper will be based on the following :-

- (a) Sessional Examination : 50% of the total internal marks of each paper.
- (b) Home assignment, Seminar / Co-Curricular and Class Attendance above 75% and 50% of the total internal marks of each paper.

⑨ Ans → A "defect" has been defined in Section 2(4) of the Act as "any fault, imperfection or shortcoming in the quality, quantity, performance, or on standard which is required to maintain by or under any law for the time being in force on any contract."

⑩ Ans → The Consumer Protection Act 2019 has widened the scope of the definition of "consumer goods or services" to include persons who buy or buy or avail of goods or services online or through electronic means, which was not present in the Consumer Protection Act 1986.

⑪ Ans → Two reasons for listing a complaining:
 (a) Goods: any defect in goods, changing of excess prices, sale of hazardous goods, adoption of unfair contract, unfair or restrictive trade practice by the trader.

(b) Services: any deficiency in services, changing of excess prices, offering of hazardous services, adoption of unfair contract, unfair or restrictive trade practice by the service provider.

⑫ Ans → Error of Commission is an error that occurs when a bookkeeper or accountant records a credit to the correct account but to the wrong subsidiary account or ledger.



Report of initiatives taken for Advanced and Slow learners


