





#### SEC—Historical Tourism in Assam and North-East India: Sri Surya Pahar, Goalpara

On 24-12-2021 the Department of History, P.B. College, Gauripur organized an educational field trip to Sri Surya Pahar located in Goalpara, Assam. The trip was aimed at providing students with an enriching of historical and archaeological significance, as well as to explore the cultural heritage of Assam.






