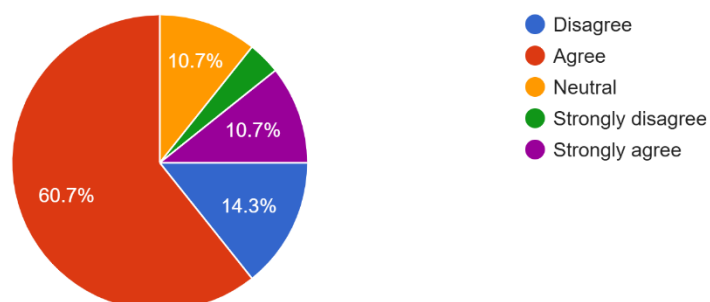

1. The quality of existing classroom infrastructure supports a satisfactory teaching-learning environment

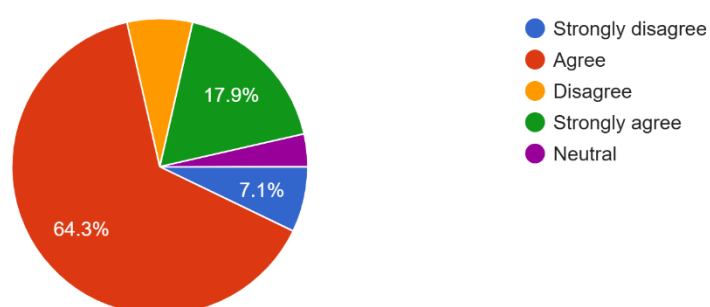

2. Classroom furniture, electrical equipment etc. are adequate to meet the needs of the students and teachers

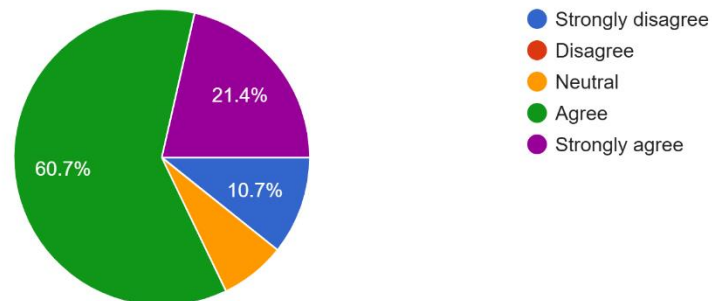

### 3. There is adequate access to ICT tools for effective teaching

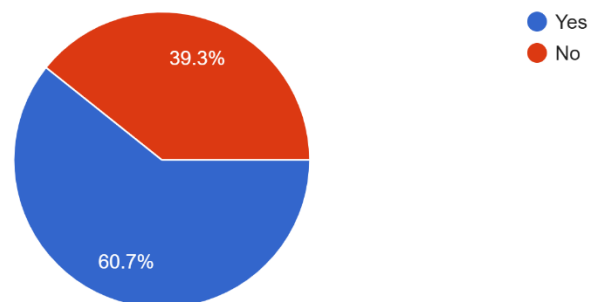

### 4. There is access to high speed and uninterrupted Internet/ Wi-fi facilities

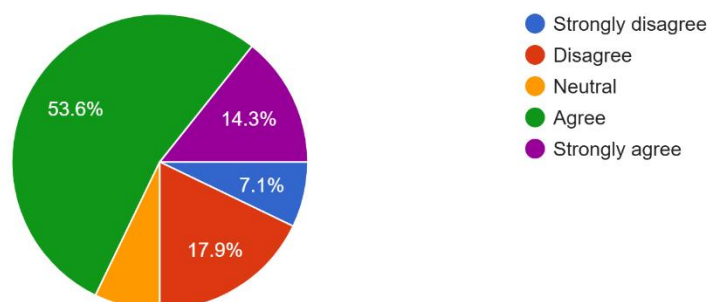

### 5. Faculty Rooms are sufficiently furnished to accommodate the teachers

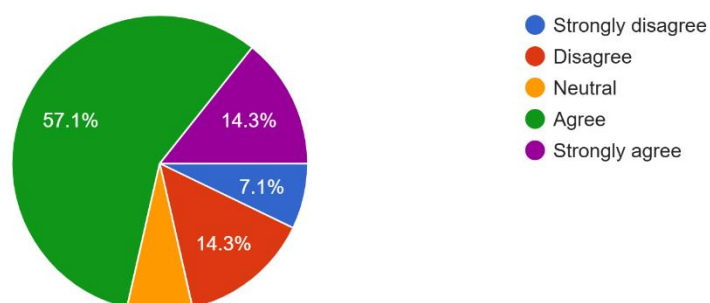

### 6. Safe and hygienic drinking water facilities are available for the faculty in/ near the faculty rooms

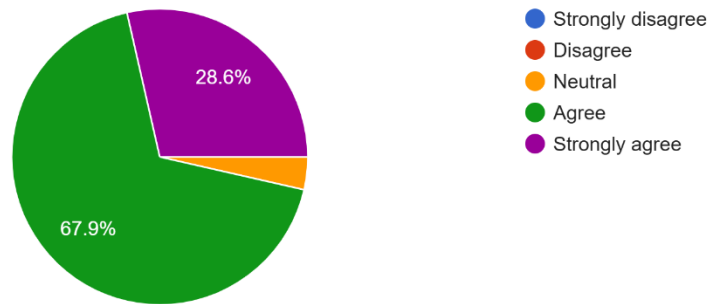

7. The teachers are provided with sufficient stationery materials for day-to-day work

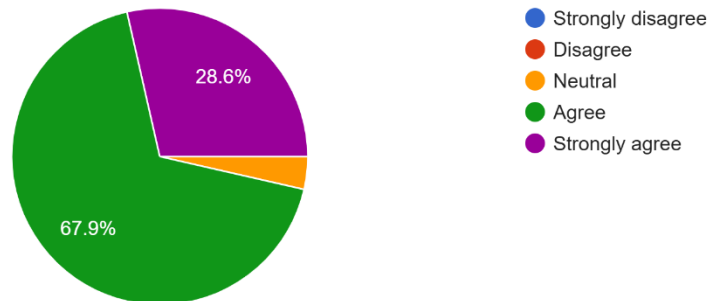

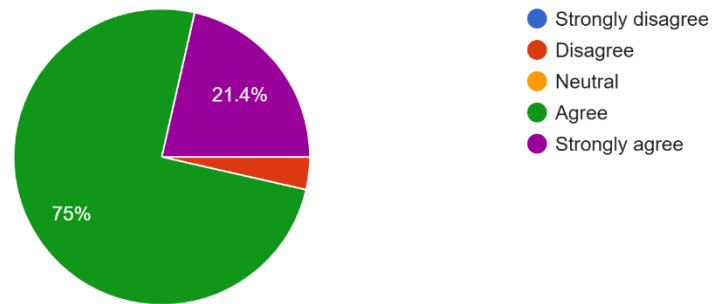
8. The College administration encourages the faculty for Research and Career Advancement

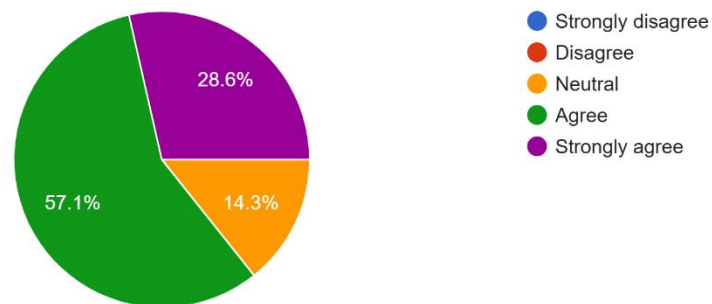

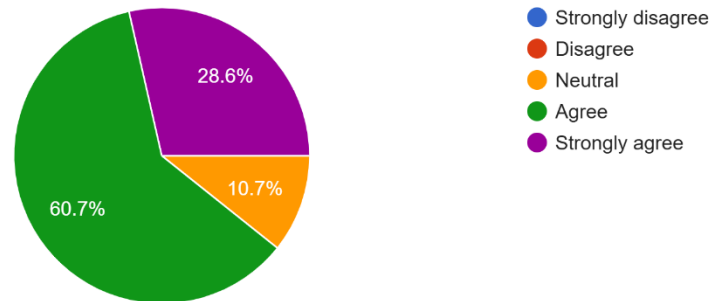
10. The college library provides adequate access to books, journals, magazines etc.

11. The computer laboratory of the college is adequate for conducting computer aided classes for students

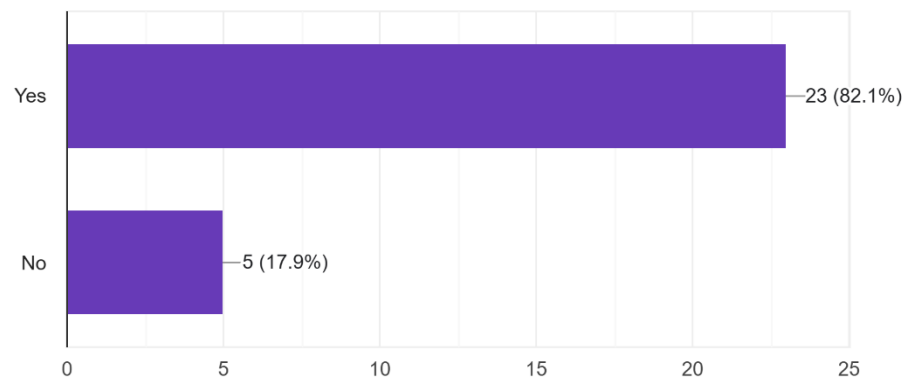

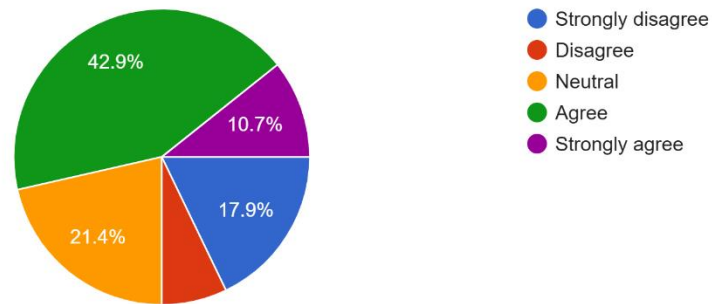
12. Cleanliness is maintained throughout the college campus

13. The washrooms for faculty are clean and hygienic and are maintained properly

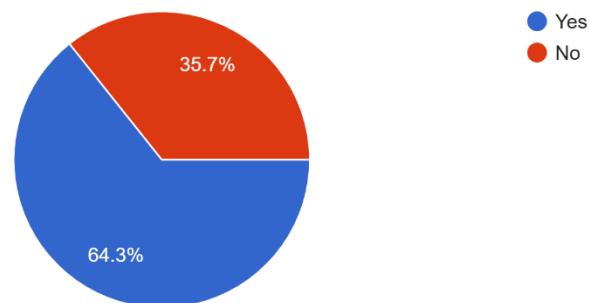

14. The college canteen is adequately furnished to accommodate the teachers and students simultaneously

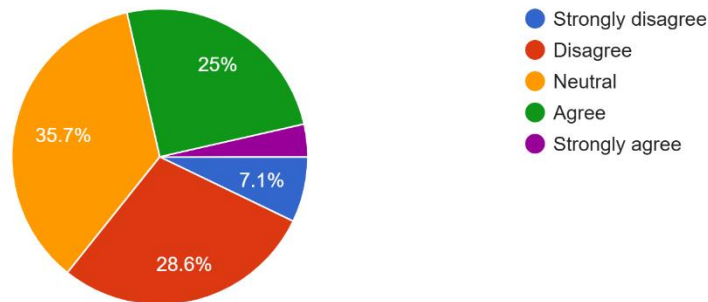

#### 16. Summary of Suggestions:

Based on the feedback provided, there are several key areas that require improvement on campus. The most prominent concern is cleanliness and hygiene. Feedback consistently highlights the need for more cleaners, particularly for washrooms (including ladies' urinals and teachers' common washrooms) and various departments (Hindi, Arabic, and Sanskrit). There is also a strong emphasis on improving the cleanliness and hygiene of the campus canteen, along with the quality of its food.

Another major area for improvement is campus infrastructure and facilities. This includes a need for better, more reliable internet and Wi-Fi access in classrooms and departmental rooms. There are also requests for more and larger rooms with adequate furniture, the provision of clean drinking water facilities near departments, and the installation of a shed over the first floor of the RUSA building to mitigate extreme heat. Furthermore, there's a call to increase the number of ICT-enabled classrooms.

Finally, while some feedback praises the current state of the college, there are suggestions related to academic and administrative improvements. One faculty member expresses a desire for academic excellence, a collaborative environment, and a focus on innovation under the principal's leadership. Other suggestions include addressing shortages, improving recreational facilities for both students and faculty, and encouraging everyone to take responsibility for saving energy and keeping the campus clean.
